# Regarding the environmental impact assessment for the "Nordhavn - Lynetteholm" project

The Energy and Environment Agency (hereinafter – the Agency), acting as a Point of Contact of Latvia regarding Notification in accordance with Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (hereinafter – the Espoo Convention) and the competent authority on the environmental impact assessment (hereinafter – the EIA) in Latvia, would like to express gratitude to the Ministry of Green Transition for notification sent regarding the environment impact assessment for the "Nordhavn – Lynetteholm" project (hereinafter – the Project). The Agency hereby acknowledges the receipt of the Ministry of Green Transition letter No 2025-12669 dated 3 September 2025<sup>1</sup>.

Please be informed that the Agency published received information regarding the Project on the Agency's webpage<sup>2</sup> and send information directly to the involved authorities. The Agency has received response from the Ministry of the Climate and Energy of the Republic of Latvia, the Ministry of Smart Administration and Regional Development, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Latvia, the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Latvia in cooperation with the Health Inspectorate, the Ministry of Agriculture of Republic of Latvia and the State Environmental Service. The Agency has not received written comments from the public.

The Agency has gathered and evaluated opinions expressed by mentioned stakeholders and agrees with general estimation that Latvia is not likely to be affected to such an extent by the development of the Project that would require participation in the EIA of the Project and transboundary consultations under the Espoo Convention. Latvia has no comments regarding the scope of the EIA of the Project.

Though Latvia does not intend to take part in the transboundary consultation process as an affected party, we kindly ask the Ministry of Green Transition to inform us about the findings of transboundary impact, especially if negative impacts on the environment are possible on the territory of Latvia, and the results of the EIA of the Project.
