On transboundary EIA

The Ministry of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection of the Republic of Belarus, to fulfill the obligations assumed by the Republic of Belarus under the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (hereinafter referred to as "the Espoo Convention"), informs of the following.

In connection with the intention expressed by the Republic of Latvia to participate in the transboundary environmental impact assessment (hereinafter referred to as "EIA") procedures for the project "Construction of a disposal and temporary storage facility for radioactive waste" and in accordance with paragraph 2 of Article 4 of the Espoo Convention, we hereby forward the EIA report in Russian and English and the non-technical summary of the EIA report in Latvian. During the preparation of the EIA report, the developer of the planned activity took into account the relevant comments and proposals received from your country.

***For reference.*** In accordance with the EIA programme, it is expected that the transboundary EIA procedures will last up to 5 months from the date of this letter.

In accordance with paragraph 2 of Article 4 of the Espoo Convention, we kindly request you to distribute the EIA report among the concerned competent authorities and the public of your country for effective participation and possible comments and proposals on the EIA report and the project as a whole.

Taking into account the above, we kindly request you to:

2. submit comments and proposals on the assessment of the potential environmental impact of the project on your country, including comments and proposals received from the public.
